

# **International Workshop: T lymphocyte dynamics in acute and chronic viral infection**

**This Workshop aims to:**

- **Bring together researchers and clinicians from a variety of backgrounds to discuss T cell responses in control of acute and chronic infections**
- **Encourage interdisciplinary cross-fertilisation of ideas - specifically between immunology and mathematics**
- **Identify key areas for future research and to encourage collaborative working in these areas**

**By bringing together scientists from different backgrounds we aim to gain better understanding of the role of T cells in acute and chronic infection. We will discuss why some infections are cleared from the host while others persist, how we can tip the balance towards clearance or better control of otherwise persistent infection, and the contribution of anti-viral T cell responses to pathogenesis / protection.**

**The workshop will consist of plenary talks, free papers and interactive discussion workshop sessions.**
